# Introduction

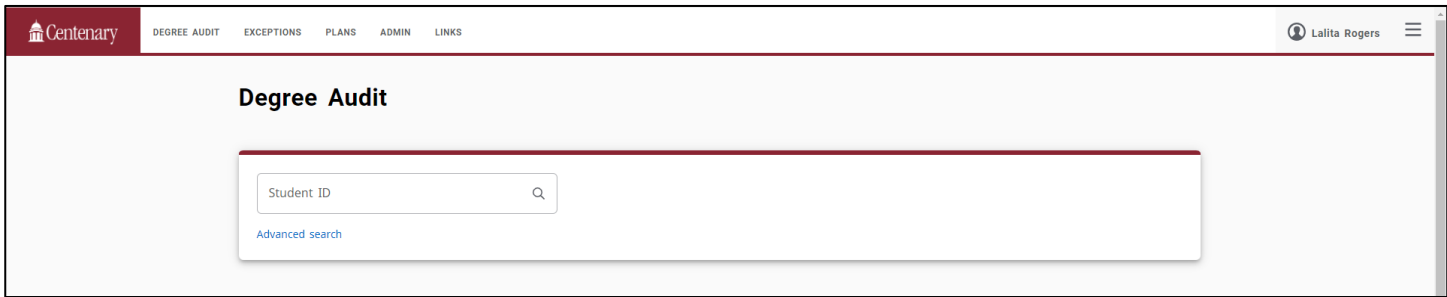
Degree Works is a web-based tool that helps students and advisors monitor progress toward completing a degree. Degree Works uses degree requirements from the College catalogue and the student’s transcript to produce an easy-to-read degree audit that shows the completed and remaining courses for graduation. Degree Works uses a responsive dashboard, which is modern, clean, and designed to display well on tablets and phones.

# Navigation Bar

The Degree Works audit worksheet is divided into several sections, called blocks, which together comprise your degree audit. The types and number of blocks may vary from student to student, depending on the academic program declared and the student's level (undergraduate versus graduate). Degree Works will audit the courses in-progress and in a student's academic history against the stated requirements for the declared academic program to allow students to track their progress toward completion. If you are pursuing more than one degree (i.e., BA and BS degrees), click on the drop-down arrow in the navigation bar under “Program” to select which degree audit you’d like to view.

The following is an overview of the blocks students or faculty will likely see on the degree audit worksheet.

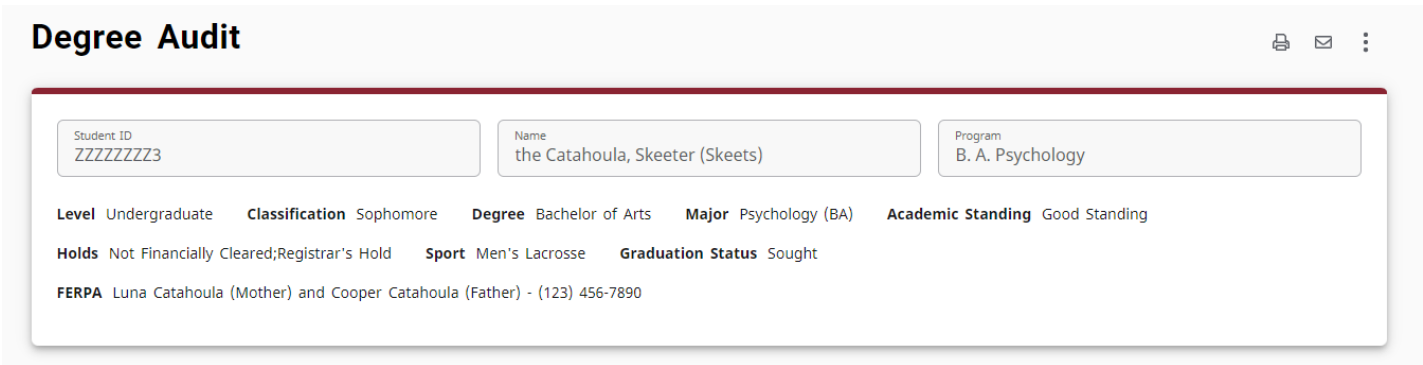
# Landing Page (Faculty ONLY)



After signing into Degree Works, you have the option to enter the ID number for the student in question or use the Advanced Search feature to identify an individual student or group of students.

# Student Header (Landing Page for Students)

In the Student Header block, important information is displayed from different fields such as the student’s name, ID, classification, academic program information (degree type, college, major, minor and concentration, if applicable), holds (if applicable), graduation status, FERPA release, etc.

## Graduation Calculator

This is used to estimate your potential graduation GPA by using the current GPA, the semester hours remaining, those required and the desired GPA. The current GPA is automatically entered.

4. The system will advise you whether or not the desired GPA is achievable and what is necessary in order to make that happen.

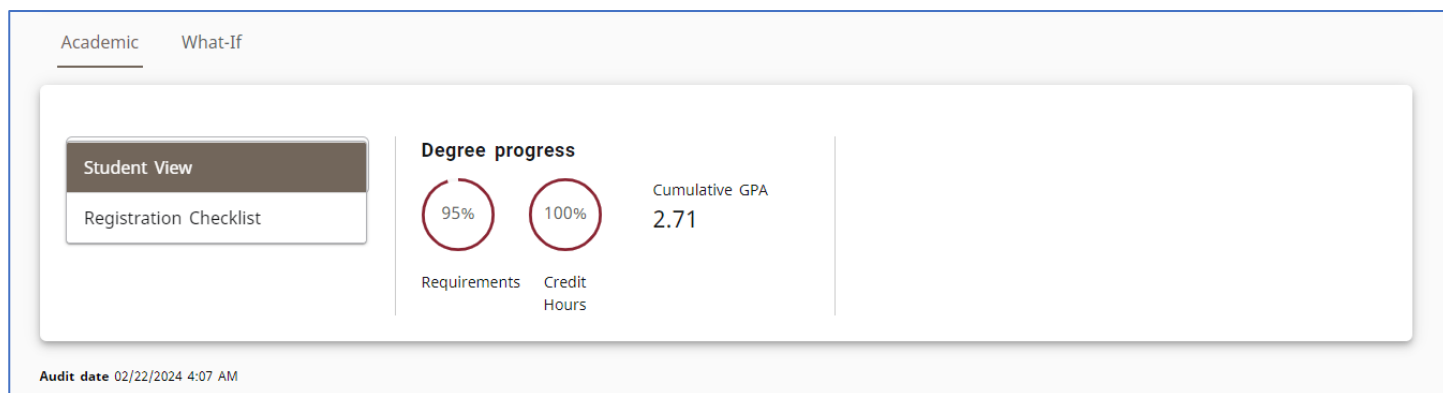

## Degree Progress

The Degree Progress shows the percentage complete of the student's requirements and credits and are displayed as dials. The student's overall GPA is also located here, which only includes grades earned in Centenary courses, not transfer courses.



The Requirements progress will not always equal the Credits progress. Progress will not equal 100% until all courses are complete and grades have been processed in the system. A graduating senior who has completed all credits and course requirements and is preparing for graduation will reach 98% until the grades are submitted at the end of the term.

## What-If

The **What If** feature allows students to select other degrees, majors, minors, and/or concentrations to determine how the coursework they have already taken would apply to a new or additional academic program. This can be helpful when students wish to evaluate a change to their current degree, major, minor and/or concentration. Students and advisors may also use the What If function to determine if a change in catalog year is beneficial to the student. Students may choose to follow the requirements of their matriculation year, their graduation year, or any year in between. Changing the catalog year on the What If function can allow students to see the curricular differences between catalog years for their field of study. From the main Worksheet, Student View, click **What If** on the left. From within the **What If** area, then select the Degree, Catalog Year, Major, Minor, etc., to indicate which academic areas to consider in the What-If audit, then click **Process** to view a new audit. The **What-If** audit is a planning tool only and is not an official change of major or any other academic program.
