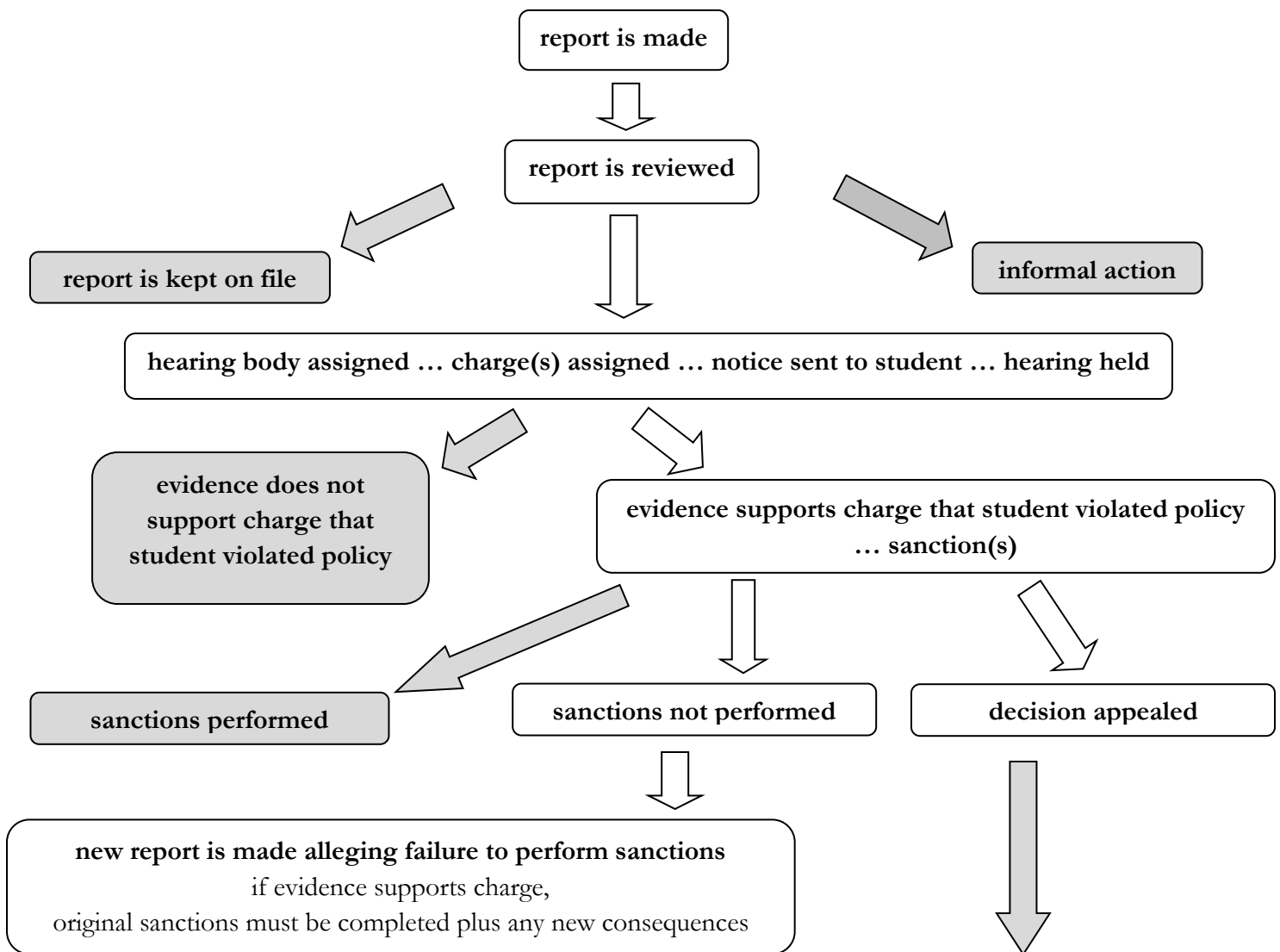


Student Conduct Case Flowchart



appellate bodies (multiple appeals possible)

- If the previous hearing body was a Hearing Officer and case was about policies regarding residential buildings and areas surrounding them, the appellate body is the Residence Halls Association (RHA).
- If the previous hearing body was RHA, the next level appellate body is the Conduct Review Committee.
- If the previous hearing body was a Hearing Officer and case was about non-residential policies, the appellate body is the Conduct Review Committee.
- If the previous hearing body was the Conduct Review Committee, the decision is usually considered final, though appeals can be made to the Dean of Students.
- The President is included in the due process procedure for students who have been found to have violated academic and/or behavioral policies of the College and as the President, is available as the last source of appeal of a decision made by the Dean of Students.
